

Implementing Mapper.

Once classes have been set up and the words have been added to your curriculum, it's vital to consider what you want your learners to encounter and when. We recommend that learners complete 5 words per session; this can easily be changed in the individual class page in Mapper.

To do this, consider **why** you are using Mapper. The following will help you clarify this:

Pre-teaching

"I'd like to enhance my learners' confidence with vocabulary and concepts before they begin a topic"

- Make the start and end date active for a fortnight prior to the topic beginning
- Ensure that learners are prepared and understand that they will not initially be familiar with the content, and that this is deliberate!

Co-teaching

"I'd like to reinforce key concepts and vocabulary during the teaching of a unit"

- Depending on the topic you're teaching, and the range of terms, set the start and end dates for a smaller range of terms during each week of a unit
- Set learners a minimum requirement of two sessions per week

"I'd like to continually reinforce a range of concepts and vocabulary over an extended period of time"

- Select round 30 high utility words that learners will encounter through a longer period of time over more than one topic and set the start and end dates for longer periods- around a month, for example
- This works especially well for subjects that are tied together with larger underpinning themes

Revision

"I'd like to give my learners the opportunity to recap key vocabulary and concepts after they have completed a topic"

- Sequence words to appear over a longer period of time in different topics within your subject.
- When learners log in, they will see that they can continue learning different topics; under their subject of English, for example, they will be able to select from Macbeth, A Christmas Carol and An Inspector Calls
