




### Introducing your reporting dashboard. Impact data where you need it - at your fingertips.

Bedrock Learning is a powerful platform for both **baseline tests** and **ongoing assessment**, giving you vital data insights into literacy improvement in your setting.

- Your **live teacher data dashboard** clearly shows you progress, usage and attainment metrics.
- Data can be filtered to see progress data for different groups (SEND, Pupil Premium, EAL, gender etc).
- All data, across all reports, can be exported to share with key stakeholders, allowing leadership teams to easily track this crucial area of teaching and learning and ensure consistency across the school.

### The Alpha test (vocabulary)

This initial, adaptive placement test assesses each learner's existing vocabulary. Learners are then automatically placed in the block of learning activities most appropriate to their level.

### The Holistic Assessment (grammar)

This 25 question test (covering all knowledge and skills in the curriculum) is taken at the beginning of all learning, right at the start of each Grammar unit. Operating as a **diagnostic test**, it gives visibility to teachers of the areas learners are confident in and those they need to work on. This data can help **personalise teaching** and differentiate within the classroom. A second summative assessment is undertaken at the end of the learning to provide teachers with **clear progress data** to evaluate the **impact** of this curriculum.

### **Ongoing summative assessment**


Bedrock is continually generating summative assessment data for all learners through **pre and post tests** that bookend each topic in both our Tier 2 and Tier 3 Vocabulary and our Grammar curricula.

### **Ongoing formative assessment**
